He asked: Messenger of Allah (ﷺ), this is the killer (so naturally he should go to the Hell), but what is the matter with the slain? He replied: He intended kill to companion.

All praise is due to Allah (SWT), and peace & blessing on his noble Messengers (AS), in particular, on the last of them all the blessed Prophet Muhammad (SAAW).

This time around, Eid al-Fitr passed in a state of confusion and uncertainty. How could one even extend greetings for Eid when the innocent children, women, and elderly of Gaza were being subjected to the worst kind of Zionist oppression—and Muslim countries remained indifferent, some even lending support to Israel's cause?

During the blessed month of Ramadan and on the occasion of Eid, the ground reality was that Muslim nations—particularly the Arab states—maintained silence in the face of the brutal atrocities being inflicted upon the Muslims of Gaza. These are the very Arab countries that, barely a month earlier, had hastily gathered in Egypt under U.S. President Trump's threats and agreed—precisely in line with Israeli demands—on the complete elimination of Gaza's resistance movement and the establishment of a puppet government (echoing extraordinarily with the Palestinian Authority 'government' in the West Bank, led by Mahmood Abbas!).

The truth is, the condition of our beloved Palestine weighs heavily on the heart—laden with sorrow, shame, and remorse. In such circumstances, where is the joy of Eid to be found?

The agreement between Hamas and Israel brokered by USA and Qatar on 15 January 2025, and slated to come into effect on 19 January 2025, had already reached its inevitable demise before it could even be enacted. The Zionist regime went so far as to perform its symbolic funeral. According to the distorted and false teachings of Judaism, all of humanity apart from the Jews is considered even lower than insects and pests (aka goyims or gentiles). Therefore, no matter how inhumane their actions may be—inflicting brutal oppression, committing genocide, mass murder, targeting children, women, and the elderly, committing war crimes and crimes against humanity—they believe they will not be held accountable before the Almighty.

Operating on this false ideology, Israel shredded the so-called agreement to pieces. It obstructed humanitarian aid to the besieged and oppressed Muslims of Gaza. It denied the entry of heavy machinery necessary for the reconstruction of over 90% of destroyed homes, hospitals, schools, refugee camps, and government buildings in Gaza which they had destroyed themselves. During Ramadan, Gaza's electricity and gas supplies were predominantly cut off, and its only plant that desalinates sea water for drinking was incapacitated.

Moreover, Netanyahu announced plans for more illegal Zionist settlements in the West Bank, and implementation has already begun. During the so-called ceasefire, Israeli forces continued to systematically target and cause the shahadah of Palestinian Muslims in the hundreds on a daily basis.

Today, war criminal Netanyahu and his cabinet ministers openly declare that they will settle for nothing less than the complete genocide of Gaza's Muslim population—and that Greater Israel shall indeed come to pass.

Then on 18 March 2025, Israel, true to its deceitful and brutal nature, launched a massive missile strike on the entire length and breadth of Gaza, causing, according to official figures, (continued on page 2)

the shahadah of at least 634 people—most of them women and children. Some senior leaders of the resistance movement were also targeted. The so-called guarantors of the ceasefire agreement—USA and Qatar—did not utter even a single word of condemnation over this horrifying crime against humanity.

The indifference and cowardice of other Arab and Muslim countries were no different. The United Arab Emirates even exceeded all limits in its pro-Israel stance, sentencing to death three individuals who had participated in the killing of a Zionist military officer and an agent of the Israeli spy organization 'Chabad', Rabbi Tzvi Kogan. What a degree of disgrace and moral decline!

It appears as though Muslims, by and large, have chosen the path of hypocrisy, coupled with fear of the enemy and love for this worldly life, wrapped in luxury and the fear of death —except those whom (SWT) Allah has protected.

During all this, a 10-member delegation of Pakistani-origin individuals visited Israel. One female member of the delegation gave an interview to Israeli media, praising the "noble traits" of Jews and the "humanitarianism" of Israel. She even advised Pakistan to formally recognize Israel. One wonders whose narrative she was echoing!

In truth, Muslims have turned their backs on the divine mission entrusted to the Ummah by Allah (swt) and His Messenger (SAAW) and are now living an artificial life. Meanwhile, the children, women, and elderly of Gaza sit upon the rubble of their homes, steadfast in the remembrance of Allah (swt), committed to protecting Al-Aqsa Mosque. They carry the bodies of their beloved who have embraced shahadah, journeying towards Paradise. Despite the abundance of blessings in the broader Muslim world, its rulers, elites, and the vast majority of masses lack true faith, trust in Allah (swt), adherence to the commands of the Holy Prophet (SAAW), and a sense of accountability in the Hereafter.

In contrast, the people of Gaza—despite tear-filled eyes, starvation, and utter deprivation—remain content and resolved due to their unwavering trust in Allah (SWT), patience, and firm determination. It is a comparison so stark that one's soul feels crushed under the weight of its own sins.

The Palestine issue is not merely a political problem; it encapsulates numerous human crises. The selective silence of human rights NGOs—who otherwise constantly raise alarms over agendas thrust down their throats by the modern Western civilization—exposes their clear bias. The New (or Jew) World Order can no longer conceal its brazen callousness.

In developed nations where even animal rights are fiercely defended, what of the over six million humans who, over the past seventy-seven years, have had their land violently usurped? These displaced people now live in hunger, poverty, and disease in refugee camps. Their humble homes have been bulldozed, replaced by tall buildings erected by Zionists—built on a claim that is wholly false: neither historically valid, nor supported by altered religious scripture, nor recognized by international law.

The Zionist occupation state in Palestine is, in fact, the last ugly remnant of Western colonialism. Just as colonial forces were expelled from other Muslim regions, they will inevitably be driven out of the Holy Land—if not today, then tomorrow.

Ideally, all of humanity should rise to resolve this humanitarian catastrophe and save the world from descending into a wider war. The opportunity for repentance still exists. Undoubtedly, the Zionists are powerful today, but their dominance is not insurmountable. Believing otherwise reflects a defeatist mentality. No Dajjali force can ever overpower the Might of Allah (SWT), nor can it transcend the limits set for humanity.

The Jews, too, are creatures created by Allah (SWT); they did not create themselves. Yet, when it comes to the rise and fall of nations, Allah (SWT) has established certain divine laws. Just as other nations have experienced their decline, so too will the Zionists not remain powerful forever.

As for Pakistan, every student of history knows that the founder, Muhammad Ali Jinnah, declared the Zionist state of Israel to be an illegitimate child of the West. Over the past 77 years, with backing from the U.S. and Europe, that illegitimate entity has grown so powerful that it has unleashed unspeakable horrors on the Muslims of Gaza over the past 18 months.

The reality is that a great humanitarian tragedy is unfolding in that sacred land—a land whose sanctity and blessings are affirmed repeatedly in the Holy Qur'an. India deploys troops after deadly protests over Muslim Endowment Law

Indian authorities have deployed troops to crack down on deadly protests in the eastern state of West Bengal over a recently passed controversial bill that critics say would dilute the rights of Muslims to manage religious endowments (waqf) worth more than \$14bn. As protests over the federal Waqf amendment law in West Bengal's Muslim-majority Murshidabad district escalated, resulting in three deaths and the arrests of more than 150 people, according to The Times of India newspaper.

The daily said on Sunday that the Calcutta High Court had ordered the "immediate" deployment of the paramilitary Border Security Force (BSF) to the area. Karni Singh, inspector general of the BSF's South Bengal Frontier division, said forces were sent to "help" local police, not for "independent action".

The law, which amended a 1995 law on governing waqf or Muslim properties donated for religious or charitable purposes, was passed earlier this month after heated debates in both houses of Parliament, later signed by the president making it a law.

Waqf refers to personal property – movable or immovable – that is permanently donated by Muslims for religious or charitable purposes. However, the inclusion of non-Muslims in managing the waqf properties has caused concern among Muslims, who say the federal government led by the Hindu nationalist Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) is discriminating against them, as other religious groups are still allowed to manage faith-based institutions.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's BJP claims the amendments are aimed at bringing transparency and fighting corruption and mismanagement in waqf governance. But Muslims fear that changes to the 1995 law could leave waqf properties, including historic mosques, shops, shrines, graveyards and thousands of acres of land, vulnerable to confiscation, dispute and demolition.

The opposition says it is an attack on India's Muslim minority, who form some 15 percent of India's 1.4 billion people, guaranteed in India's secular constitution. Opposition Congress Party leader Rahul Gandhi has said the bill is "aimed at Muslims today but sets a precedent to target other communities in the future".

Empire in Decline: When Pseudo-Conservatives confuse Chaos for Revival

As the so-called liberal elite—more accurately described as the pseudo-liberal establishment—continues its retreat from key decision-making positions within western regimes, an equally hollow pseudo-conservative force appears to be stumbling into power. Rather than restoring order or coherence, this emerging bloc is accelerating the unraveling of the established imperial framework through a volatile mix of ideological confusion and political amateurism. While the political incompetence of the self-proclaimed "conservatives" is frequently on display—particularly through their flagship socio-political movement, MAGA—the deeper ideological incoherence of this quasi-fascist current often escapes serious scrutiny.

This oversight is unsurprising. Identifying such systemic contradictions demands a level of analytical rigor rarely found in sensationalist media or the performative discourse of social media. The term *conservative* traditionally refers to individuals or institutions committed to conserving or preserving established norms, institutions, or values. But this begs the question: what exactly is it that today's western conservatives are trying to preserve?

A superficial reading, shaped by mainstream narratives, might point to Christian nationalism as the defining ideal. However, this is a lazy oversimplification. A closer look at the political, intellectual, and personal histories of leading western conservatives reveals that many are far removed from Christian values and lifestyles. Conservatives are, in essence, outdated liberals clinging to yesterday's liberal orthodoxy, albeit repackaged in a crude nationalist aesthetic. This dissonance is not lost on thinkers such as Aaron Renn.

Contemporary western conservatism is largely defined by a single unifying framework: the preservation and resurgence of western hegemony. From Canada's Stephen Harper to Germany's Alice Weidel, the common thread is a yearning to restore western dominance—a goal often cloaked in alarmist rhetoric about defending "western civilization" from Muslims. Ironically, it is this very objective that may hasten the decline of the west-centric global order. By framing Muslims as the existential threat, these movements create dangerous blind spots, diverting attention from the real and pressing internal challenges their societies face—challenges that have little, if anything, to do with Islam.

The clearest embodiment of this reality is the erratic and incoherent policymaking under the Trump regime. In the United States, the internal cannibalization of the conservative movement has already begun and is especially visible due to the primitive and emotionally driven nature of American political discourse. One particularly vivid manifestation is Steve Bannon's increasingly public attacks on Elon Musk—an example of ideological fragmentation within the movement. This internal collapse is also more visible in the US than in Europe due to a growing realization among the MAGA base that unconditional support for Israel may be detrimental to America's domestic interests and foreign policy credibility.

Given the constant barrage of political spectacle under Trump, we will avoid focusing too deeply on the MAGA phenomenon here. Instead, let us turn our attention to Europe—a more "sophisticated" manifestation of western neo-colonialism, though no less troubled. Europe's political landscape is more deeply rooted in its historical consciousness than the carnival-like chaos of American politics. Yet even there, the signs of deep internal decay are emerging.

It is only a matter of time before modern-day fascist mimicking political movements across Europe begin cannibalizing each other. If history is any guide, this process will be particularly brutal. At present, the European version of this phenomenon is unfolding in slow motion. For instance, Germany's Alternative für Deutschland (AfD) was recently expelled from its pan-European parliamentary group, Identity and Democracy. This rupture signals not only ideological divergence but also strategic fragmentation. There are several reasons why this European cannibalization is progressing more slowly. Intellectually, the European left remains more robust and far more popular than its American counterpart. The pseudo-liberal elite in Europe, though weakened, still retain pockets of influence.

Moreover, the twin specters of Islam and Russia continue to dominate domestic narratives in many European countries, offering diverse political movements a shared external "enemy" to rally against—for now. Still, the trajectory is ominous. Europe, a continent that twice plunged the world into devastating wars, may once again draw on its historical memory to justify nationalistic revanchism. It is not difficult to imagine a future where one nation's sense of unjustly denied "rights" ignites a geopolitical chain reaction on the European continent once again. When the inevitable intra-right infighting among Europe's far-right factions reaches a critical point, the consequences will extend beyond the continent.

The geopolitical implications will be significant—not only for Europe but also for Russia, Iran, Türkiye, and perhaps the broader Global South.

Enforcement of the Waqf (Amendment) Act by the Extremist Modi Government is a Direct Attack on the Religion and Culture of Indian Muslims.

The malevolent alliance between Jews and Hindus is bent on the genocide of Muslims...

Lahore (PR): These views were expressed by the Ameer of Tanzeem e Islami, Shujauddin Shaikh, in a statement. The Ameer said that the real aim of the Waqf (Amendment) Act is to enable extremist Hindus to seize control of mosques, madrasas, shrines, and graveyards belonging to Muslims in India. History bears witness that the management and administration of these properties have been the responsibility of Muslims for centuries. However, according to the amended law, two non-Muslim members will be included in the Wagf Board, which will leave more than 600 Wagf properties—spanning approximately 950,000 acres—under constant threat of Hindu encroachment. Furthermore, the power to designate properties as Waqf now lies with the local Collector, who is expected to make decisions aligned with Modi's agenda. The Ameer added that RSS thugs have already laid false claims of ownership on 30,000 mosques. Additionally, Modi, during his election campaign, has openly declared his intention to abolish the personal laws of Indian Muslims. The Ameer said that the that the extremist, rather terrorist government of the BJP has long been implementing the Israeli model of Muslim genocide. In the past 18 months, the illegitimate Zionist state of Israel caused the shahadah of more than 50,000 Muslims through relentless bombardment of Gaza—most of whom were women and children. Similarly, the 900,000-strong occupying Indian army stationed in occupied Kashmir regularly perpetrates massacres of Muslims. Now, Muslims living in India have also become a primary target of Modi's regime. He further said that a disturbing similarity between these two diabolical regimes is their unrelenting pursuit of expansionist ambitions. On the one hand, Netanyahu is presenting maps of a Greater Israel, while on the other, Narendra Modi is practically advancing toward the realization of an "Akhand Bharat" (Greater India). The events of nearly the past seventy-seven years have proven that it is futile to expect any good, justice, or support for the oppressed from the United Nations or similar international bodies. Therefore, the approximately two billion Muslims residing in the 57 Muslim-majority countries must take practical steps to solve their own problems and counter the intrigues of malevolent global powers. Once the countries that commit atrocities against Muslims, support them or remain silent in the face of such injustices, realize that the Muslim world is united and capable of taking economic and military actions in response, then terrorist states like Israel and India will not dare to cast an evil eye toward Muslims. The Ameer said that the need of the hour is for Muslim countries to set aside their internal differences, unite as a collective force, and take concrete measures to support oppressed Muslims around the world. This would once again instill fear in the hearts of the disbelievers and enable real support to be provided to the oppressed. If the Muslim world strives to establish and implement the Deen of Allah—that is, to revive the institution of Khilafah—then not only will their worldly affairs improve, but they will also be eligible to attain success in the Hereafter. Muslim countries must unite and take concrete and practical measures against Zionist brutality.

The real solution to Israeli atrocities lies in enforcing an economic boycott and delivering a military response.

Lahore (PR): These views were expressed by the Ameer of Tanzeem e Islami, Shujauddin Shaikh, in a statement. He stated that the world recently witnessed a unique event in diplomatic history when President Trump summoned Ukrainian President Zelensky to the Oval Office at the White House, only to humiliate him along with his associates. The financial aid that the Ukrainian president had hoped to secure from the U.S. did not materialize. Instead, the U.S. unilaterally converted nearly \$350 billion in past aid into a loan. In return, Ukraine was asked to surrender all its mineral resources. The reality is that Ukraine finds itself in this predicament today because, nearly 30 years ago, it handed over all its nuclear assets and missile technology to Russia under an agreement. The United States, European nations, and Russia had guaranteed Ukraine's defense under that agreement. Had Ukraine retained its nuclear capability, Russia would not have dared to attack in 2022. The Ameer further remarked that the question frequently raised by Pakistan's secular, liberal groups, and NGOs—regarding why an economically struggling Pakistan needs to maintain its nuclear capability—has been answered by the recent Oval Office incident. He emphasized that Pakistan's past decision to join the U.S. war in Afghanistan inflicted such severe damage on the country that its repercussions are still felt today. There is no benefit for Pakistan or the region in handing over another "Sharifullah" to the U.S. or in inviting the U.S. back under the pretext of counterterrorism cooperation. Former U.S. Secretary of State Henry Kissinger was absolutely right when he said, "America's enemy may survive, but its 'friend' never does." Therefore, Pakistan must abandon any illusions of friendship with the U.S., as history has shown that such alliances have only harmed Pakistan. The current policies regarding counterterrorism appear to be failing. It is imperative to involve all stakeholders and formulate policies that serve the nation's best interests. Pakistan was founded on the basis of Islam, and its survival also depends on the implementation of the Islamic system. May Allah (SWT) grant the people of Pakistan the wisdom to learn from President Trump's treatment of President Zelensky and to recognize their true adversaries. Ameen!
